Mozzy Project

Our "Mozzy" project aims to raise funds to supply treated mosquito nets and medication to help fight the scourge of malaria in the Central African region of Massaka, Uganda.

To date we have raised over £2,000 for nets and treatments.

The project comes with leaflets explaining the dangers posed to young children from mosquitos and malaria. These leaflets are suitable for Sunday School children and adults. Each leaflet contains one square of self-adhesive netting to stick on to one of the posters shown below.

The small poster has space for 25 squares of net (£25 to cover) and the large raises £50 when fully covered.

Tools for Rwanda

The aim of our Harvest TOOLS project is to raise funding to purchase sets of tools for local families who struggle to find the money.

A full set of tools consists of one hoe, a pickaxe and a spade and costs only £10 in Rwanda, Central Africa.

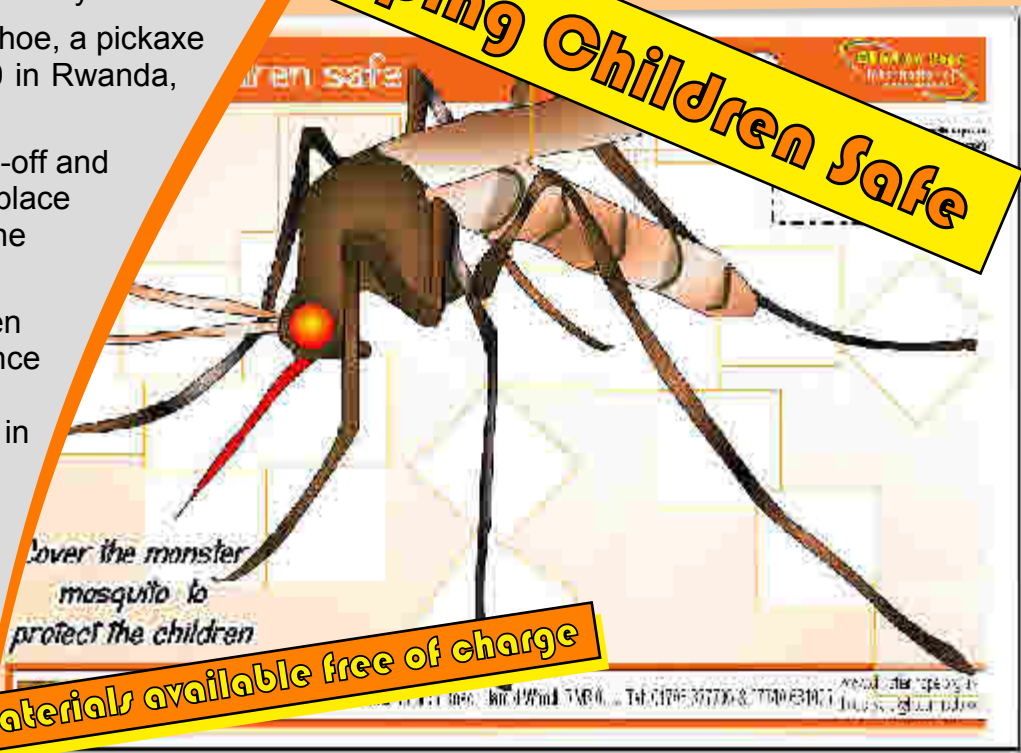
We can supply a poster with peel-off and stick-on patches to symbolically place tools into the hands of some of the poorest people in Rwanda.

There are also leaflets for children and adults explaining the difference between mechanised farming in Europe and subsistence farming in Central Africa.

Each completed poster will raise £50 to enable five sets of tools to be purchased in Rwanda.

The project will be overseen in Rwanda by the Diocese of Shyogwe.
