

## ALL-IN-ONE VEST

**Chest size** 18 (20,22) ins. Use size 8 (4 mm) needles and DK wool.

Cast on 74 (80, 86) sts and work in k1, p1 rib until work measures 8 (9½, 11) ins. Cast on 4 (6, 8) sts at beg of next 6 rows and 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Work these 4 sts in garter st as sleeve borders. 106 (124, 142) sts. Rib 2 (4, 6) rows keeping 4 sts garter st at each end.

### DIVIDE FOR NECK

Work 38 (44, 50) sts. Cast off 30 (36, 42) sts work remaining 38 (44, 50) sts in rib for 3½ (4½, 5½) ins leaving first set of sts on spare needle and ending at neck edge.

Cast on 30 (36, 42) sts break off wool, rejoin to first set of sts on spare needle. Rib 3½ (4½, 5½) ins on these sts ending at neck edge. Knit across 30 (36, 42) sts cast on sts and across other 38 (44, 50) sts. 106 (124, 142) sts. Rib 8 rows, cast off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows and 4 (6, 8) sts at beginning of following 6 rows. 74 (80, 86) sts. Continue in rib until work measures 8 (9½, 11) ins. Cast off. To finish off neck, crochet loops and drawstring to gather up neck. Stitch drawstring into place at back of neck to prevent pulling through. Or, with set of size 10 sock needles pick up 38 (40, 42) sts on each of 3 needles evenly around neck 114 (120, 126) sts and work 2 rounds in p1, k1 rib. 3<sup>rd</sup> round. p1, k1 wool fwd k2 tog to end of round. Work 1 more round in rib. Cast off in rib. Thread ribbon or crochet chain through holes and stitch to back of neck to prevent pulling through.

## BABY CARDIGAN

**Chest size** 16 (18, 20, 22) ins. Double knit. Size 10 (3¼ mm) and size 8 (4 mm) needles.

### BACK AND FRONTS WORKED TOGETHER TO ARMHOLES

Using size 10 (3¼) needles cast on 107 (117, 131, 139) sts and work in k1, p1 rib for 6 (10, 10, 10) rows.

Change to size 8 (4mm) needles and work straight in st st until work measures 4½ (5½, 6, 7½) ins ending with a wrong side row. Next 4 rows purl. Divide for back and fronts as follows.

### RIGHT FRONT

With right side of work facing k26 (28, 32, 34) sts. Leave remaining 81 (89, 99, 105) sts on spare needle. Continue in st st on these 26 (28, 32, 34) sts until right front measures 2¾ (2¾, 3½, 4) ins from armhole ending with a purl row.

### SHAPE NECK

Next row cast off 4 (4, 4, 4) sts. Knit to end. Decrease 1 st at neck edge on next 4 (4, 6, 6) rows. 18 (20, 22, 24) sts. Continue on remaining sts until work measures 5 (5½, 6, 6½) ins. Cast off.

### BACK

With right side facing rejoin wool to stitches on spare needle and k55 (61, 67, 71) sts leaving remaining sts on spare needle. Knit the back in st st on these 55 (61, 67, 71) sts until work measures 5 (5½, 6, 6½) ins ending with purl row. Cast off.

### LEFT FRONT

Rejoin wool to remaining 26 (28, 32, 34) sts and work in st st until work measures 2¾ (2¾, 3½, 4) ins ending with a right side row.

### SHAPE NECK

Next row cast off 4 (4, 4, 4) sts purlwise and knit to end. Decrease 1 st at neck edge on next 4 (4, 6, 6) rows 18 (21, 22, 24) sts. Continue in st st until work measures 5 (5½, 6, 6½) ins. Cast off.

### SLEEVES (BOTH ALIKE)

Using size 10 (3¼ mm) needles cast on 31 (31, 33, 33) sts and work 13 rows in k1, p1 rib.

Next row increase. Rib 3 (1, 3, 3), make 1, rib 5 (4, 3, 3), 5 (7, 9, 9) times, make 1, rib 3 (2, 3, 3). 37 (39, 43, 43) sts.

Change to size 8 (4 mm) needles and work in st st increasing 1 stitch at each end of 3<sup>rd</sup> and every following 4<sup>th</sup> row until there are 49 (55, 61, 61) sts.

Continue until work measures 6 (6¾, 7, 7½) ins ending with a purl row. Cast off.
