

5<sup>th</sup> row. K1 (1, 2, 2)(sl 1, k1, pssso, k4 (6, 7, 9) k2 tog) 4 times k2 (1, 3, 2).  
 7<sup>th</sup> row. K1 (1, 2, 2)(sl 1, k1, pssso, k2 (4, 5, 7) k2 tog) 4 times k2 (1, 3, 2).  
 9<sup>th</sup> row. K1 (1, 2, 2)(sl 1, k1, pssso, k0 (2, 3, 5) k2 tog) 4 times k2 (1, 3, 2), 11 (18, 25, 32) sts.  
**2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> sizes only**  
 11<sup>th</sup> row. K1 (1, 2, 2)(sl 1, k1, pssso, k (0, 1, 3) k2 tog) 4 times (10, 17, 24) sts.



**4<sup>th</sup> size only**  
 13<sup>th</sup> row. K2 (sl 1, k1, pssso, k1, k2 tog) 4 times k2. 16 sts remaining

**ALL SIZES**

Next row. K1 (0, 1, 0) k2 tog to end of row and run yarn through all stitches and fasten off.

**NECK EDGE**

Join crown seam. With size 10 (3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> mm) needles cast on 38 (42, 46, 50) sts. Fold over garter stitch border and with right side of work facing, pick up 4 sts through double thickness and then pick up 30 (34, 38, 42) sts evenly along neck edge of bonnet and 4 sts through garter stitch border double thickness. Cast on 38 (42, 46, 50) sts. 114 (126, 138, 150) sts. Knit 2 rows. Cast off.

**BOOTEES (Pair both alike)**

Using size 10 (3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> mm) needles and double knitting wool cast on 29 sts and work 4 rows in garter stitch. Change to stocking stitch and work 14 rows.

Next row. K1 (wool forward, k2 tog) to end of row.

Divide for instep. P20 turn, k11 turn. Work 17 rows in st st on these 11 sts. Break off wool. Rejoin to right side of instep and pick up 10 sts along side of instep, k11 instep sts, pick up 10 sts down left side of instep and knit remaining 9 sts from other needle. 49 sts.

Work 9 rows in garter sts then shape foot as follows.

1<sup>st</sup> row. K1, k2 tog, k15, k2 tog, k9, k2 tog, k15, k2 tog, k1.

2<sup>nd</sup> row. Knit

3<sup>rd</sup> row. K1, k2 tog, k14, k2 tog, k7, k2 tog, k14, k2 tog, k1.

4<sup>th</sup> row. Knit.

5<sup>th</sup> row. K1, k2 tog, k13, k2 tog, k5, k2 tog, k13, k2 tog, k1. Cast off.

**TO MAKE UP**

Stitch sole seam edge-to-edge, stitch up back seam.

Thread ribbon or crochet chain and thread through eyelet holes.

Secure so that baby cannot pull ribbon through.
