

# Knitted Anniversary Blanket

*You will need:-*  
 3.75mm (9) knitting needles  
 DK knitting yarn

## ABBREVIATIONS -

**DK** = double knit,  
**k** - knit,  
**p** = purl,  
**sl st** = slip stitch,  
**patt** = pattern,  
**beg** = beginning,  
**sts** = stitches



*N.B. This blanket can be knitted in squares as given in instruction below or in long strips.*

*If working in strips, 2 rows of knit can be work in between the blocks to form an outline, this contrast colour can then be used to join them to complete the effect.*

## Pattern 1

Cast on 50sts  
 Row 1-4 - knit  
 Row 5 - sl1, k2 (k1, p1) to last 3sts, k3  
 Row 6 - sl1, k2 (k1, p1) to last 3sts, k3  
 Row 7 - sl1, k2 (p1, k1) to last 3sts, k3  
 Row 8 - sl1, k2 (p1, k1) to last 3sts, k3  
 Repeat rows 5-8 to form pattern  
 Continue until 78 rows have been worked from the start.  
 Rows 79-82 knit  
 Cast off or join in new colour for next block.

## Pattern 2

Cast on 50sts  
 Row 1-4 - knit  
 Row 5 - sl1, knit to end  
 Row 6 - sl1, k2, purl to last 3sts, k3  
 Row 7 - sl1, k2, (p2, k2) to last 3sts, k3  
 Row 8 - as row 6  
 Row 9 - as row 5  
 Row 10 - sl1, k2 (k2, p2) to last 3sts, k3  
 Repeat rows 5-10 to form pattern.  
 Continue until 78 rows worked from start.  
 Rows 79-82 - knit  
 Cast off or join in new colour for next block.

### Pattern 3

Cast of 50sts  
Row 1-4 - knit  
Row 5- sl1, k2, (k4, p4) to last 7sts, k7  
Row 6 - sl1, k2, (p4, k4) to last 7sts, p4, k3  
Row 7 - as row 6  
Row 8 - as row 5  
Repeat rows 5-8 to form the pattern.  
Continue until 78 rows have been worked from the start.  
Rows 79-82 - knit  
Cast off or join in new colour for next block.

### Pattern 4

Cast on 50sts  
Row 1-4 - knit  
Row 5 - sl1, k2, (k2, p2) to last 3sts k3  
Row 6 - as Row 5  
Row 7 - sl1, k2 (p2, k2) to last 3sts, k3  
Row 8 - as Row 7  
Repeat rows 5-8 to form the pattern  
Continue until 78 rows have been worked from the start.  
Rows 79-82 - knit  
Cast off or join in new colour for next block.

### Pattern 5

Cast on 50sts  
Row 1-4 - knit  
Row 5- sl1, k2 (k4, p4) to last 7sts, k7  
Row 6 - sl1, k2 (p4, k4) to last 7sts, p4, k3  
Row 7-10 - repeat Rows 5-6 twice  
Row 11-12 - sl1, knit to end  
Row 13 - sl1, k2, (p4, k4) to last 7sts, p4, k3  
Row 14 - sl1, k2, (k4, p4) to last 7sts, k7  
Row 15-20 - repeat Rows 13-14 3 times  
Row 21-22 - sl1 knit to end  
Row 23-30 - repeat rows 5-6 4 times  
Row 31-32 - sl1 knit to end  
Repeat rows 13-32 to form pattern.  
Continue until 78 rows have been worked from the start.  
Rows 79-82 - knit  
Cast off or join in new colour for next block.

### Pattern 6

Cast on 50sts  
Row 1-4 - knit  
Row 5 - sl1, k2, p1 (k2, p6) to last 6sts, k2, p1, k3  
Row 6- sl1, k2, k1 (p2, k6) to last 6sts, p2, k4  
Row 7 - sl1 knit to end  
Row 8 - sl1, k7 (p2, k6) to last 8sts, k8  
Row 9 - sl1, k2, p5 (k2, p6) to last 10 sts, k2, p5, k3  
Row 10 - sl1, k2, purl to last 3sts, k3  
Repeat Rows 5-10 to form the pattern.  
Continue until 78 rows have been worked from the start.  
Rows 79-82 - knit  
Cast off or join in new colour for next block.

To finish your blanket sew in all ends.  
Join squares to make a blanket.  
An edging can be worked to complete the blanket.
